THE FOLLOWING QUOTE IS FROM THE LAST SERMON IN CRACOW IN CELEBRATION OF THE THIRD OF MAY, 1978 BY CARDINAL KAROL WOJTYLA BEFORE BECOMING POPE JOHN PAUL II

"After all, each one of us possesses a heritage within us- a heritage to which generations and centuries of achievement and calamity, of triumph and failure, have contributed: a heritage which somehow takes deeper root and grows new tissues from every one of us. We cannot live without it. It is our soul. It is this heritage, variously labelled the Fatherland on the Nation, by which we live. As, Christians, we live by this Polish heritage, this Polish Millennium, this Polish Christianity of ours. Such is the law of reality..."
