REPORT FROM SECRETARY, JOYCE HILLSON

PAST EVENTS OF THE SOCIETY INCLUDING HIGHLIGHTS OF BUSINESS MEETINGS OF MARCH 3, 1992 AND APRIL 7, 1992.

AT THE MARCH 3, 1992 MEETING, BY-LAWS AS RECOMMENDED TO THE MEMBERSHIP BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE WERE ACCEPTED BY A UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE MEMBERSHIP.

Show & Tell - Tell & Show followed with sharing of information about personal genealogical research with one another. Ralph Lysyk gave an explanation of how he personally uses PAF software. AT THE APRIL 7, 1992 MEETING
PRESIDENT ED MENDYKA RETURNED TO LEAD
THE SOCIETY'S BUSINESS MEETING AND TO
INTRODUCE GUEST SPEAKER ANN SINDELAR
OF THE WESTERN RESERVE HISTORICAL
SCCIETY.

Ann Sindelar's presentation gave us a comprehensive look at the work of the Western Reserve Historical Society as it safeguards the history of our community and maintains its vital records, and pointed out the role of W.R.H.S. as a valuable resource for genealogists living in Greater Cleveland.

DOCUMENTS AVAILABLE TO RESEARCHERS AT THE W.R.H.S. WERE OUTLINED FOR US AND MISS SINDELAR EVEN SPECIFIED OTHER TYPES OF RESEARCH INFORMATION WHICH CAN BE FOUND AT OTHER RESEARCH LOCATIONS IN GREATER CLEVELAND.

A PORTION OF HER PRESENTATION WAS DEVOTED TO THE W.R.H.S. ACQUISITION OF THE 1920 CENSUS, EXPLANATION OF HOW GENEALOGISTS CAN BENEFIT FROM ITS CONTENTS. MOST IMPORTANTLY SHE OUTLINED THE PROCEDURE WE NEED TO FOLLOW TO ACCESS INFORMATION SPECIFIC TO EACH OF OUR RESEARCH NEEDS.

THE PGS OF GC WOULD LIKE TO EXTEND OUR WARMEST THANKS TO MISS SINDELAR.

LATER, ED GAVE THE SOCIETY A
REVIEW OF NEW ADDITIONS TO OUR "HONOR
SYSTEM" LENDING LIBRARY. HE FURTHER
ACKNOWLEDGED THE FOUR VOLUMES DONATED
BY THOMAS MARTIN SWATLOSKI OF LOUISIANA.

THE ISSUE OF BRINGING IN NEW MEMBERS WAS ADDRESSED. DISTRIBUTION OF PACKETS OF INFORMATION, WHICH NOW TOTALS MORE THAN 80 PAGES, IS NOW LIMITED TO DUES PAYING NEW MEMBERS.

- SEVEN PAGES OF INFORMATION RELATED TO THE USE OF THE 1920 SOUNDEX CENSUS INDEX AND GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE W.R.H.S. THE CALENDAR OF EVENTS FOR THE W.R.H.S. GENEALOGY INSTITUTE FOR 1992 WAS ALSO MADE AVAILABLE. THESE SEVEN PAGES ARE AN EXCELLENT FOLLOW-UP TO THE PRESENTATION BY ANN SINDELAR OF THE W.R.H.S. AT THE SOCIETY'S 4-7-92 MEETING.
- Ten pages relative to the Ancestor Index Card File with concentration on translations of words and names common to Polish Genealogical records were also distributed.
