GOLCOWA

Continued from last newsletter—

THE POSTWAR YEARS

The first patrols of the Soviet army appeared in Golcowa on July 27, 1944. With their arrival, the nightmare of the war years was at an end. The Nazi armies were retreating and the Soviet forces were advancing. Liberation and the sweet smell of freedom was in the air. One would think that peace and harmony would once again reign in this little village tucked away in the foothills of the Carpathian mountains. Such was not the case however.

The first few months after liberation were filled with unrest. With the breakdown of authority, villagers were taking the law into their own hands. Old wartime misunderstandings, clashes and quarrels resurfaced and the time for settling old accounts had arrived. Acts of thievery occurred. Cases of vigilante justice happened. Political differences brought on some of these tragic occurrences. For a time, a group from Lwów was temporarily quartered in the village. Reliving some of their past history when they had to flee Lwów before the Soviet armies in 1939, they now attacked a convoy of wagons which was returning from the front with Soviet soldiers. Several were killed. Accounts were settled with informants and collaborators.

Gradually, in time, the unrest subsided and the villagers began rebuilding their lives as well as their village. Men and women returning from the forced labor camps in Germany brought home with them their own wartime experiences. They now sought to incorporate into their way of life the technical advancements they had seen in Germany.

Conditions in Golcowa, in the years immediately following the war, were still quite primitive, much like they had been before the war. The houses for the most part were constructed of wood with thatch roofs. There was no electricity in the village, no running water in the homes, no medical facilities available for the sick and hygienic conditions left much to be desired. There was more than enough work to do for everyone to try to ameliorate the lot of the struggling peasant.

The teachers in the village undertook the task of stamping out illiteracy. They realized that the educational process had been severely distorted during the wartime years and they now felt that there was much catching up to do. Courses were created that accelerated the training and educational processes of the students. The basic education which was a term of seven years, was filled with as much as the students could absorb. Youth groups were organized in Golcowa and Różanka. They produced their own plays and shows, held sporting events, games, picnics, festivals and the like. All this activity served to bring the youth of the upper and lower regions of the village together in a spirit of camaraderie.

An unexpected feature of the village in the immediate postwar years was overpopulation. (*Ed. Com.— It is indeed strange that such was the case since many villagers had been taken to Germany to the forced labor camps and never returned to their homes. Other villagers had served in the military and had either been killed or were now in “displaced persons” camps, refusing to be repatriated because of the Soviet occupation of their homeland. With the severe population dislocations in Eastern and Central Europe at the time however, Golcowa now found itself with more people than it could feed and house properly.*) There were approximately 700 homes and 2800 inhabitants.

Soon after the war, agitators appeared in the village. (*Ed. Com.— The author calls them agitators. More likely they were government agents who were anxious to settle the “recovered lands” as quickly as possible with as many people as possible. The*

"recovered lands" were those areas that were German before the war but had been awarded to Poland in compensation for the areas taken from Poland in the east.) They were encouraging the local population to immigrate to the "recovered lands". And indeed, many did. To the Province of Wrocław went: Józef Mikoś with his family, Feliks Tomoń, Stefan Wójcik, Franciszek Herbut, Feliks Bogacki, Franciszek Barański, Bernard Kobiałka, Eugenia Wolanin, Stanisław Hadam, Tomasz Filip, Jan Świder and Edward Świder. To the Olstyn Province went: Jan Bąk, Ignacy Dobosz, Maria Bacior and Waclaw Bąk. Michał Wróbel, Józef Duplaga, and Maria, Tadeusz and Józef Kopczyk left to resettle in the Bieszczady mountain region. Until 1975, there was an exodus from the village of about five families per year. They sold their properties and left for Rzeszów, Krosno and Sanok.

THE FIFTIES—

Beginning in the Fifties until the end of the century, changes would take place which would transform the village of Golcowa beyond any recognition to what it was before the Second World War. The changes started slowly enough. The home-crafts industry was reestablished. The main product of this activity was baskets.

On July 1, 1953, an Office of Post and Telecommunications was opened when a telephone line was strung between Domaradz and Golcowa.

THE SIXTIES—

The decade of the sixties would be the most important decade of the village in its history. In 1960, a cooperative venture, a modern department store, was opened in the neighboring town of Dynow. An agreement was entered into with the department store to buy all the products of the home craft industry for the domestic as well as for export markets.

In April of 1960, for the first time in its history, an electric light shone in the village. Gone forever were the oil lamps of the past. On wintry days, with the short daylight hours and long evening and nighttime hours of darkness, the villagers now could light up their homes and barns and continue to work to improve their homesteads instead of retiring early. They also occupied their time by reading books which they could now borrow from the local public library which had been established about this time. With the electrification of the village, all manner of electrical appliances made their appearance. First of all, radios and TV's appeared. The most popular programs on these two media outlets were those having to do with agriculture. Farmers learned about how to best utilize their land, how to increase their average yield. They learned about new farming techniques, new farming implements, their use and maintenance. Soon after the appearance of radios and TV's, all kinds of electrical appliances began to make their debut in the village. Washers, refrigerators, vacuum cleaners and other labor saving devices were being sought after and bought to ease the lot of the village housewife.

In 1960, the local farmer's association received two tractors which ushered in the era of farm mechanization. As time went on, more and more agricultural implements such as sowers, threshers, binders and mowers were introduced into farming routines. Where formerly manual labor was the rule, now, more and more of the hard labor was being performed by machines. In 1961, for achieving their agricultural quotas (*Ed. Com.—Remember that the Communists were still in power at the time and quotas were the "order of the day"*) the villagers received a financial reward with which they purchased a film projector and were granted permission to show films.

In 1960, the first house built of bricks was completed. More of these brick houses were to follow. In 1962, a deep water well was built in Golcowa with the accompanying piping system. In 1966 a large, covered water reservoir facility was built in Różanka to better supply that area with water.

In 1961, a committee was formed to look into establishing a medical and dental health clinic for the village. Temporary quarters were found and work began to adapt the facilities to meet the perceived needs. On October 1, 1962 the clinic was opened and from that time, a visiting doctor and dentist came to the village three times a week to see patients. In 1965, a new health care facility was built containing medical and dental offices, administrative offices and living quarters for a doctor. In 1973, the health care facility was taken over by the *National Office of Health Care*.

Planning for a road building program was launched in 1964 by upper echelons of government and work began in 1965. Golcowa was now linked to most of its neighboring villages and towns by good roads. Bus service was instituted between Golcowa and Brzozów and Golcowa and Krosno in August of 1975. Students in search of a higher education than elementary school, could now commute to schools outside the village. New roads continued to be built and new bus routes opened so that now even the villagers could commute to jobs outside the village should they want to do so and if the job opportunities presented themselves.

THE SEVENTIES AND BEYOND—

During the seventies all manner of improvement were made. In themselves, they might be considered small or minor improvements but taken collectively, they improved the overall character of the village and the life-style of its inhabitants. In 1971, the pumping system which supplied water to the health care facilities, to the fire station and to the school was improved. In 1974-75, a new postal facility was built which could now process packages as well as letter mail. In 1977, a 15 acre communal orchard was created to serve the needs of the villagers.

The eighties were a time for continued improvements in the village. The health care facilities were enlarged and overhauled to meet the greater demand of the villagers. New bus routes were opened. One was between points: Brzozów-Domaradz-Golcowa-Przysietnica and another was between Golcowa and Sanok. Golcowa was no longer isolated as in years passed but now was connected to villages and towns in the entire region. In 1982, a sport-shoe factory was located in the area which employed 25 people, predominantly women. In 1986, a new fire station was completed and a new fire engine purchased.

But the single greatest investment in money, time and energy of the villagers in the postwar era was the building of a new church in Różanka. The need for such a church had been long recognized to serve the spiritual needs of the population in this area. In the early seventies, word reached Golcowa that Błażej and Karolina Dobosz, native Golcowians who had emigrated to the USA and settled in Cleveland, were willing to donate a sizeable sum (believed to be \$25,000) for the building of a chapel in Różanka. From this point forward, it was determined that with the help of this donation, a new church and not just a chapel, would be built in the area.

In 1973, a start was made when a newly constructed barn was bought to serve as a temporary church, to be remodeled and rebuilt. A large wooden cross was attached to the apex of the roof and the first mass and blessing of the church occurred on June 9, 1974. In time, all the walls of the temporary structure were replaced. There were times when 200 volunteers from the village showed up to work on this project. It was indeed a community undertaking.

In 1975, three bells were purchased for the church. The largest was given the name *Holy Trinity*. The medium bell was christened *Heart of Jesus* and the smallest of the bells was called *St. Joseph*. Each bell was inscribed with its name and the name of the donor, Błażej and Karolina Dobosz. On the 600th anniversary of the Diocese of Przemysł, in June of 1976, the bells were blessed.

In 1978, the interior decor of the church was completed. Following this, an organ was bought and assembled. An altar made of marble was installed. The pews of the church were made of solid oak. The area around the church was landscaped and finally on June 21, 1981, the church was consecrated and given the name *Heart of Jesus*. A plaque was embedded in an exterior wall to commemorate the event. It was the pride of the entire area. Indeed, the whole community had a hand in its building. And not to be forgotten, was the generosity of Clevelanders, Błażej and Karolina Dobosz. Now, there were two churches to serve the faithful, the centuries old and historical church of *St. Barbara's* in Golcowa and the newly constructed church, *Heart of Jesus*, to serve the needs of the people of Różanka.

(Ed. Com—It is just as well to end this short sketch of the history of Golcowa at this point. This is the final installment. There is much more in the book entitled Golcowa by Benedykt Gajewski but what is set down here is perhaps what is most interesting to the reader. One thing which is most evident from this short history is the perseverance of these people. Generations have lived through wars, revolutions, plagues, famines, floods, droughts, all kinds of disasters, natural and man-made. And still, they survive. Can any of us even imagine what our lives would have been like if we didn't have electricity until 1961? Their lives have been hard without many of the amenities which we in the USA take for granted. They continue to go on, true to their heritage, their customs and their belief in their God. And, all of us should be proud of these, our ancestors, and thank God that He saw fit to allow us to be the progeny of such as they.)
